- + The redesigned landscape spans five acres of green space over top of a parking garage, creating a garden-like experience set within the surrounding city blocks.
- By removing extensive concrete areas, water features and a small ancillary building, the new landscape now features mature specimen trees and drought tolerant, adaptive planting.
- The site enhances productivity by offering diverse outdoor areas for work and socialization.
- Terraces, AV-enabled outdoor workstations, and meeting pods enable occupants to move seamlessly between indoor and outdoor environments. This focus on flexible, technology-enhanced outdoor spaces underscores the project's commitment to supporting work-life balance.
- Meandering walkways and open turf areas facilitate connectivity and movement throughout the campus.
